ENTRANCE REQUIREMENT FOR ART HISTORY MAJORS

Students planning to major in art history must take a two-hour essay assessment as they finish the Art Appreciation, Art History Survey I, and Art History Survey II sequence of classes. The exam will be administered during the early part of the fall and spring semesters and will cover material introduced in the lectures and texts for these three courses. Student responses will be evaluated for basic writing mechanics, ability to form a thesis and argue it logically, and knowledge of the core objects and monuments of art history. Upon completing the assessment, each new art history major will be assigned a mentoring tenured or tenure-track faculty member who will present the assessment results and discuss areas of the student's preparation needing development. The mentoring relationship between faculty member and student will be maintained throughout the student's time at the University. The entrance requirement (assessment and mentoring relationship) will not discourage or prohibit interested students from majoring in art history. Students **will not** be allowed, however, to make a degree plan for an art history major without completing this requirement.

MINORS FOR ART HISTORY MAJORS

While a foreign language is recommended as the minor, particularly for student who anticipate pursuing graduate studies in Art History, students may select another minor outside the College of Visual Arts and Design. All art history majors are required to complete a foreign language through the sophomore year.

CAPSTONE COURSE FOR ART HISTORY MAJORS

Art History majors must successfully complete AEAH 4848 *Art History Senior Seminar* in order to graduate. This course, offered annually, will require students to demonstrate the following competencies:

1. Proficiency in the history and literature of methodologies appropriate to the seminar topic.
2. Proficiency in the analysis of artworks using one or more methodologies relevant to the seminar topic.
3. Knowledge of key discourses, themes, issues, vocabularies, and/or monuments relevant to the seminar topic.
4. Proficiency in art historical research.

The competencies will be assessed over the course of the semester through seminar discussion, examination(s), and/or research paper(s). Unsatisfactory results will delay graduation. Record of success in demonstrating the competencies will be furnished the student and recorded for the College of Visual Arts and Design.

STUDENTS WHO DO NOT HAVE AN OFFICIAL DEGREE PLAN ON FILE BEFORE THE SEMESTER THEY PLAN TO GRADUATE MAY NOT APPLY FOR GRADUATION.
